### CODE OF CONDUCT

Students who attend the Homeschool Prom at the Troy Rec will be held to a high standard of conduct. We expect students to conduct themselves in an honorable manner.

1. Prom is a formal evening, and a **dress code will be enforced**. Roaring '20s attire is encouraged but not required. Dresses may be long or short; however, short dresses must **be no shorter than the top of the knee**. Leggings will be permitted under dresses. Slits in long dresses may be no higher than the top of the knee. Low cut backs on dresses must not show bra strap. No cut outs below the bra strap. No cleavage, nothing see-thru or sheer. No midriff's showing. If wearing a suit, collar shirts with ties, dress pants and sport coats or suit coats are fine. Of course, tuxes would be great too! After-prom: same modesty standards will apply (shorts should be no shorter than 8" inseam).
2. The following substances are not permitted: tobacco in any form, alcoholic beverages, hallucinogenic drugs, e-cigarette/vape products, or substances not prescribed by a doctor. Violation will be grounds for immediate removal from the event.
3. Students will be expected to display integrity and self-control during prom events. We expect students to dance in a manner that is honorable and not vulgar (no grinding or dirty dancing). Further, students will be expected to refrain from public displays of affection.
